Philosophy (from Greek: $\phi \iota \lambda o \sigma o \phi \iota \alpha$, philosophia, 'love of wisdom') is the study of general and fundamental questions about existence, knowledge, values, reason, mind, and language. Such questions are often posed as problems to be studied or resolved. The term was probably coined by Pythagoras (c. 570 – 495 BCE).
