A proverb is such a saying popularly known and repeated, usually expressing simply and concretely, though often metaphorically, a truth based on common sense or the practical experience of humankind: "A stitch in time saves nine." A maxim is a brief statement of a general and practical truth, especially one that serves as a rule of conduct or a precept: "It is wise to risk no more than one can afford to lose."
