Beck that was designed to measure three major aspects of hopelessness: feelings about the future, loss of motivation, and expectations. The test is designed for adults, age 17–80. It measures the extent of the respondent's negative attitudes, or pessimism, about the future. It may be used as an indicator of suicidal risk in depressed people who have made suicide attempts. The BDI test is widely known and has been tested for content, concurrent, and construct validity. High concurrent validity ratings are given between the BDI and other depression instruments as the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory and the Hamilton Depression Scale; 0.77 correlation rating was calculated when compared with inventory and psychiatric ratings. Hopelessness has been measured in clinical and population research in a variety of ways including systematic interviews 9 and validated psychometric measures such as the Beck Hopelessness Scale (BHS) 10 and the Mental Adjustment to Cancer scale. 11 There is great pressure in large-scale population studies on questionnaire size due to the volume of clinical and demographic variables that must be collected.

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
