There are dry rub on guide coats and aerosol spray versions, but they both work the same way. By spraying a contrasting color over the primer, when sanded the guide coat quickly come of the high spots, and stays in the low spots guiding where you need to further block. Guide coat is like no build paint, sanding off with the least effort possible. Sanding verses Shaping. Both sanding and shaping are done using sand paper of different grits.

My next coat, the Primer Sealer, calls for the primer to be sanded to 400 or 600 grit. Check your product to see what grit you should finish with. I think 180 was plenty good to start with (no need to start block sanding with a 60 or 100 grit.), and the step from 180 to 400 was fine, with no between grits necessary. You could do all this leveling by feel, or buy a spray-can of SEM 38203 Guide Coat (black).

### Sanding Guide Coat | International

Using a small sanding block on a wavy panel will simply make the block ride over these waves. The panel will indeed become smoother but it will still be wavy. Therefore, instead of using a short sanding block, use a long sanding board. This will bridge the high and low spots of the panel, smoothing out the wavy panel texture.

Next, block sand the repair area with P320 grit until the guide coat is removed, then re-apply the guide coat. Sand with Dual Action Sander Then, use a dual action sander with P400 - again, removing all of the guide coat. Sanding For a Basecoat Blend

### Primer Surfacer Sanding

It is a guide coat, in a rattle can from 3M. A black lacquer that sprays in little dots. Then as you block sand, any low places won't have the guide coat sanded off, so you know to deal with that area. The 'old' solution was to use different colors of primer and sand the top color down to the underneath color.
