Play this in any key using the blues formula. Use a minor third, whole tone, semitone, semitone and then back down and you ’ ve got it! Riff #2. This riff uses the same notes but in a different order. Begin on D and move to Eb back to D-C-D-C-A. All we ’ ve done here is utilize the elements of the blues scale. Same notes, different order, whole new sound!

Essentially, the blues is a specific progression that uses the C7, F7, and G7 chords. (For the sake of brevity, I ’ ll only look at playing blues in the key of C). The blues chord progression lasts 12 bars (thus the phrase “ 12-bar blues ”) that move in a familiar pattern using those three chords.

Blues Piano Run 1: Crunch Run (Beginner) If you are more of a beginner blues player, then it is essential to start off with a simple run. A simple run is a run that uses 8th notes down the piano, and there are all kinds of very cool patterns that you can use. Today, I want to to show you what I call a Crunch Run. This is a run that uses primarily 8th notes down the piano, except every few notes, you grab a 3-note “ crunch chord ” , where the notes are close together.
