Bile is both an excretory product and a digestive secretion. Bile functions to carry bilirubin formed from breakdown of worn-out RBCs. Bile contains enzymes for digestion. Gastrin, histamine, endorphins, serotonin, cholecystokinin, and somatostatin are hormones or paracrine factors that are released directly into the lamina propria.

Digestive System: Digestion refers to the mechanical and chemical breakdown of foods so that nutrients can be absorbed by cells. Digestion consists of the alimentary canal which contains all the organs that aid indigestion.
