Author-Date Style

The Chicago Manual of Style provides guidelines for two styles of source citation: notes and bibliography and author-date. Author-date style is the preferred option in the sciences and social sciences. In author-date style, an in-text citation consists of the author's name, the publication year, and (if relevant) a page number. Each citation must correspond to an entry in the reference list at the end of your paper, where you give full details of the source.

In the Author-Date system sources are cited in the text, in parentheses, and full details appear in the reference list at the end.. Example:. In-text citations: (Surname Year, Page) e.g. The question of ethnic origin in the Turkish republic has been largely irrelevant until recent times (Pope and Pope 2011, 19).

Chicago: Author-Date - Referencing Styles - at University ...

Author-Date System The author-date system is more common in the sciences and social sciences. In this system, sources are briefly cited in the text, usually in parentheses, by author ' s last name and year of publication. Each in-text citation matches up with an entry in a reference list, where full bibliographic information is provided.

A separate guide explains the Chicago Manual of Style (Notes System). Inserted at the point of reference, an in-text parenthetical citation containing the author's name and the date of publication interacts with the end documentation by pointing to a specific entry on the References List page.

Chicago author-date style. In the (social) sciences, you may be told to use author-date style instead. In this style, citations appear in parentheses in the text. Chicago author-date example The success literature of the twentieth century is “ filled with social image consciousness, techniques, and quick fixes ” (Covey 1989, 18).

If you are using the author-date system to format your Chicago style citations, you must indicate each source with a brief parenthetical citation: Include the last name of author and the year of publication in parentheses, with each element separated by a comma. Include a page number if you are quoting a particular section of a source

Chicago Style: Author-Date System The Author Date system is generally used in the physical, natural and social sciences. It uses parenthetical citations in-text, with a References List at the end of the paper. Chicago Style has two distinct formats for citing sources.

Dates in Chicago website citations Web sources should generally be cited with their specific publication date (month, day, and year). Some web sources list a revision date instead of (or in addition to) the original publication date. When a date of last revision or update is listed, use this instead, preceded by the words “ Last modified. ”

How to Cite a Website in Chicago Style | Formats & Examples

Author-date style places citations directly in the text in parentheses. In-text citations include the author ’ s last name, the year of publication, and if applicable, a page number or page range: (Johnson 2016, 23) This style of Chicago in-text citation looks the same for every type of source.

“ Chicago does not [...] require access dates in its published citations of electronic sources unless no date of publication or revision can be determined from the source. ” (CMOS 14.12) Nevertheless, some publishers, disciplines, or professors may require access dates.
