more wires coming out of the back. One of these wires should connect to the left speaker, and another should have a 3.5 mm mini plug that connects to your computer's audio output jack. If your speakers require a power source to amplify the audio, there should also be a power cord.

How do I connect computer speakers?

Many other non-USB cables can also connect to your computer via a USB converter; these cables have the standard USB-A connector on one end while the other end could have connections for other ports such as Ethernet or audio. 2. Audio Cables and Connectors 2.1 - 3.5mm headphone jack. The most common audio cable is the standard headphone jack, otherwise known as a TSR

connector. It is available in several sizes, but the most common ones used with computers are the 3.5 mm or 1/8" mini audio jack.

Rear speakers: Connect the stereo miniplug of a Y adapter cable into the Rear Speaker Out (black) on the back of the computer. Connect the other ends of the Y adapter cable into the Rear Left and Right inputs on the back of the stereo receiver or amplifier labeled DVD, Surround, 5.1, or 6 Channel.
