Contentious politics is the use of disruptive techniques to make a political point, or to change government policy. Examples of such techniques are actions that disturb the normal activities of society such as demonstrations, general strike action, riot, terrorism, civil disobedience, and even revolution or insurrection.

# What does Contentious politics mean? Definitions.net

Contentious politics represent the intersection between contention, politics and collective action. It is defined as lepisodic, public and collective claims made by one or more parties where the state is involved as either the object of such claims or as part of them; and the outcome of such events will result in gains or losses of power by at least one of the claimants (McAdam et al. 2001: 5).

### What is Contentious Politics?

[Contentious politics] means episodic, public, collective interaction among makers of claims and their objects when: (a) at least one government is a claimant, an object of claims, or a party to the claims, and (b) the claims would, if realized, affect the interests of at least one of the claimants or objects of claims. Roughly translated, the definition refers to collective political struggle.
