Delusions of parasitosis (DOP) is a term that was first introduced in 1946 to refer to patients who have a fixed, false belief that their skin is infested with parasites such as fleas, ticks, worms, or other organisms. 1 It was not until 2003 that the term "Morgellons disease" was introduced and used to refer to patients who believe they have fibers or specks in their skin.
