CBT is a relatively short-term treatment which aims to identify connections between your thoughts, feelings and behaviours, and to help you develop practical skills to manage any negative patterns that may be causing you difficulties. The earlier a diagnosis is made, the more effective treatment can be. For example, prompt use of medication may help delay symptoms, as well as improving those which already exist. A diagnosis is important to rule out other possible causes of confusion, such as poor sight or hearing; emotional changes and upsets, such as bereavement; or the side-effects of certain drugs or combinations of drugs.

The principal diagnosis is generally the focus of treatment. Provisional Diagnosis — If not enough information is available for a mental health professional to make a definitive diagnosis, but there is a strong presumption that the full criteria will be met with additional information or time, then the provisional specifier can be used.
