Medieval people were also interested in dreams, and they attempted to figure out what they meant. Often a dream would be interpret as a sign of future events, or a divine warning that someone needed to change their ways. One fascinating example of a medieval dream comes from the writings of Arnold Fitz Thedmar (1201-1275), a London alderman.

Through the works of Augustine of Hippo (354-430) the Latin middle ages knew a Neoplatonic theory of knowledge, which privileged non-visual intellect over visual forms of thought such as dreams.
