The internment camp at Frongoch was famously christened by its inhabitants “Ollscoil na Réabhlóide”, or “University of Revolution”. It was inside Frongoch that Michael Collins came to the fore as a leader among fighters for freedom. Frongoch's ‘graduates’ were to play a key role in restructuring the Irish Republican Army and prosecuting the guerrilla warfare of the Tan War (1919-21). By 1920, eight former Frongoch internees were amongst the 13-member IRA GHQ Staff.
