The guide number here (full power setting, ISO 100, and normal-angle coverage) is 37 for calculations made in meters (yellow arrow) and 120 for feet (orange). For instance, on the foot scale, $f/4 \times 30$ ft = 120, as do both $f/8 \times 15$ ft and $f/16 \times 7.5$ ft.
