Exercise 3. Same as Exercise 1, but now play TWO different chord notes per chord. Not one, not three, but precisely two. Remember, you can play only “ right notes ” . Example: Am 7 5 8 5 G 7 Am 7 5 5 G 7 8 Am Exercise 4. Same as the previous exercise, but now you are free to choose if you want to play one, two or more notes per chord.

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
