JUVENILE JUSTICE IN SOUTH ASIA - UNICEF

In South Asia, the arrest and detention of children living and working on the streets by police officers on grounds such as vagrancy, indecent behaviour or prostitution, being a public nuisance or exposed to moral danger, is reported to occur in Bangladesh, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.
