The match locale was split, with the first 12 games played in New York, USA, and the final 12 in Lyons, France. The prize fund was three million dollars, with 5/8 going to the winner. In case of a tie, the prize fund would be shared equally with Kasparov retaining the title.</p>

After the controversial decision to seed Anatoly Karpov directly into the final of the 1987 World Championship Qualifying Cycle, for the next World Championship Cycle FIDE decided to alter its decision and to reserve him a spot in the quarter-finals. Together with the 9 winners of the three Interzonal tournaments and top four players of the previous Candidates tournaments, he competed for the right to challenge Kasparov once again.</p>

Kasparov won three matches, while the first match was aborted and the 1987 match was drawn when Kasparov won "to order" in the last game (he needed to win to tie the match, just as Karpov had in 1985). Each match (besides the first one) was close and hinged on the last game.</p>

From the age of 12, the chess genius from Azerbaijan Garry Kasparov was setting new standards. After becoming the youngest player to win the USSR Junior Championship he went on to win the World Junior Championship at age 16. His style was aggressive and dynamic. On his seventeenth birthday he achieved the grandmaster title.</p>
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<p>Karpov - Kasparov World Championship Match 1984/85 A fifth match between Kasparov and Karpov was held in New York and Lyon in 1990, with each city hosting 12 games. Again, the result was a close one with Kasparov winning by a margin of 12½–11½. In their five world championship matches, Kasparov had 21 wins, 19 losses, and 104 draws in 144 games. If there was a 12-12 tie after 24 games, the World Champion would keep his title. On September 3, 1985, Kasparov and Karpov began their second World Championship match, again in Moscow.</p>
