More recent dogmatics with one author are Francis Pieper's Christian Dogmatics and Karl Barth's monumental Church Dogmatics, both of which are still cited. Since dogmatics are written to address current theological issues, there can be no once and for all dogmatics, though Pieper's dogmatics continues to represent the doctrinal position of the LCMS.
