Create A Separate Page For Title – MLA formats usually require students to create a separate page for the title which is then attached to the research paper. The title page should include the course number and date of submission along with the student's name and instructor's name in separate lines using double space.

Double-space the entire research paper, including quotations, notes, and the list of works cited. Indent the first line of a paragraph half an inch from the left margin. Indent set-off quotations half an inch as well (for examples, see 76–80 in the MLA Handbook). Leave one space

after a period or other concluding punctuation mark, unless your instructor prefers two spaces.
