Posadnik originally the prince's vicegerent in the territories constituting the early Russian state. The term was first used in the Primary Chronicle under the year 997. It later designated the highest official position in Novgorod and Pskov; the position was abolished in these cities after their annexation to the Russian state.

Chronology of Novgorod's Political History

Ontsifor Lukinich (Russian: Онцифор Лукинич) was a posadnik of Novgorod the Great in 1350-1354. He came from a Novgorodian boyar family that gave a number of posadniks to the city. He is most famous for reforming the office in 1359, increasing the number of posadniks and creating a ruling collective in the city.

Originally the posadniki were drawn from the prince's retinue (druzhina) and represented the authority of the grand prince of Kiev. But during the first administration of Mstislav Monomakh (1088-94) the posadniki were increasingly chosen from the Novgorodian boyars, thus initiating a process of dual power or two secular authorities within the town.
