The lower the number (f/1.4, f/2), the wider the aperture. And the more light the lens will allow in. When buying a lens, you should try to get this number as low as you can afford to go without sacrificing the focal length that you want. The lens that I use most is my 24-70mm f/2.8.

For a camera with a cropped sensor size (also known as APS-C), you can choose from a wide range of full-frame and APS-C lenses. Before buying any lens, you should find out your

camera's crop factor and use it to calculate the lens's effective focal length. For example, a 50mm lens will have an effective focal length of 75mm when used on a camera with a 1.5x crop factor. Although the focal length remains the same, the angle of view is reduced by the smaller sensor.
