Some pioneers of psychology, like Wundt and Helmholtz, were painstaking experimenters; others found themselves at the start of major movements, such as Ivan Pavlov, whose studies of the psychology of digestion led to the founding of modern behaviourism, and Sigmund Freud, who set out to develop a neurological model of the mind and launched an entire intellectual revolution.

History of Psychology (387 BC to Present) 387 BC Plato suggested that the brain is the mechanism of mental processes. 335 BC Aristotle suggested that the heart is the mechanism of mental processes. 1774 AD Franz Mesmer detailed his cure for some mental illness, originally called mesmerism and now known as hypnosis.
