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Supervised nursing practice is 50% of the programme and takes place in both community and hospital settings. The programmes are normally three years in length, beginning with a 12 month common foundation programme (CFP), followed by around two years in one of the four branches of nursing: adult, mental health, learning disabilities or children's nursing.
