Negative Simple Present Tense: Rumus dan Contoh Kalimat

For positive sentences: There is no auxiliary verb. We conjugate the main verb by adding s to the third person singular. For negative sentences, The auxiliary verb (do) is conjugated in the Present Simple: do, does. The main verb is invariable in base form: base. For negative sentences, we insert not between the auxiliary verb and the main verb.
