Quotes In Apa Papers

Format quotations of 40 words or more as block quotations: Do not use quotation marks to enclose a block quotation. Start a block quotation on a new line and indent the whole block 0.5 in. from the left margin. Double-space the entire block quotation.

How to Cite Quotes in APA. Include both the author and the year in the text. The page number will be in parentheses. Include only the author's name in the text. The year and page number will be in parentheses. Do not write the author's name or year of publication in the text. The name, year, and ...

Use of Quotation Marks - APA Style

APA in-text citation is generally written with the last name of the author and year of publication separated by a comma inside the parentheses, but for direct quotations, the page or paragraph number has to be included.

All examples follow APA style rules. Note that APA papers tend to include few direct quotations, as paraphrasing is the preferred method of citing sources. Quotations are normally reserved for definitions, to capture an author's apt phrasing, or to interact with the specific wording of the source (Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 8.25).
