Literature Reviews - University of Kent

The review process is scheduled to occur Oct. 1 through Sept. 30 of each year and will include identifying new and emerging risks, assessing those risks according to likelihood and severity, identifying or connecting with risk owners, developing mitigation plans, reviewing those plans with the EBC, establishing mitigation plans to report to the Board of Trustees and planning implementation steps.

The residual risk should always be lower than the original risk after the additional risk control measures have been put in place. Risk control measures They should be a combination of protective and preventative controls and you should apply the hierarchy of controls, starting at the top to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the most effective controls are used to reduce the risk.
