Scoring the running record is the easy part. Analyzing the running record is a more complex but vital step. The teacher's analysis shows "what the reader is noticing, what is easy, what is confusing," and can be used to inform future teaching by providing evidence used to target specific reading behaviors (Clay, p. 46).

Scoring a Running Record You can use the following scoring to assess a child's performance. 1. Count only the running words in a text. Running words do not include titles, subtitles, captions, and so on. 2. 3. Count each word in a skipped line as an error. Note Insertions add errors. A reader could have more errors than there are words on a line.

The running record, developed by Marie Clay, is a reliable assessment tool used by teachers to systematically record observations of a student’s oral reading using a set of standard conventions or notations. They are used by classroom teachers to record reading behaviours of individual students in Kindergarten to Grade 3.

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
