It should also match the flex in your boots. Beginners and freestylers tend to choose bindings with short, flexible highbacks (the vertical plate that rests against your Achilles tendon) for a softer, forgiving ride and easy recovery when landing jumps and tricks.

Snowboard Binding Flex The flex of your bindings should be the roughly the same as your boots and snowboard (you can see the individual flex ratings on the binding descriptions - 1 being the softest and 10 being the stiffest). For example - if you have stiff bindings and a soft boot you will find it difficult to transfer power from your boot.
