In practice, fresh diluted semen for intracervical insemination is mostly used in pigs. Semen is obtained from boars on farms or from specialised AI-centres. The latter offer a diversity of breeds and genetic lines and distribute ready-to-use semen doses of constant quality to different sow herds.

Swine Artificial Insemination for Beginners: The ...

The first and overriding principle of artificial insemination in swine is – if a sow is in standing heat, she can be bred; if she is not in standing heat, do not attempt to breed her. This key to maximizing fertility rates in the breeding herd requires a solid understanding of AI basics, timing of insemination, use of lubricants, boar usage, overbreeding and nine key semen-handling principles.

For the best results and to reduce handling stress, artificial insemination should be performed by trained staff. The first step would be to identify whether the sow is ready to be inseminated. After weaning, sows may be placed with a boar for about a half an hour each day and when she stands for the boar, she will be in what is called, standing heat.
