The Siege of Tsingtao, sometimes Siege of Tsingtau, was the attack on the German port of Tsingtao in China during World War I by Japan and the United Kingdom. The siege took place between 27 August and 7 November 1914 against Imperial Germany. The siege was the first encounter between Japanese and German forces, the first Anglo-Japanese operation of the war, and the only major land battle in the Asian and Pacific theatre during World War I.
