Tucks and Gathers — these markings resemble a square that is
missing one line; the dots at the bottom indicate where to pull in the
fabric to make it meet in the middle, and the vertical lines and dots
at the top indicate where to sew your stitches. BONUS
MARKINGS-Pattern Key- These squares refer to your printed
pattern. They are designed to keep your pattern right side up or
down when cutting.

Understanding Pattern Markings - The Sewing Loft Notch Symbols, or markings used on a pattern to indicate cutting lines, joining points, hems, dart legs, etc. IMPORTANT: Single notches always refer to the front of a pattern and a double notch always refers to the back of a pattern. A pattern notcher is an ideal tool for the job. However, a single line or triangle will do the job.

Construction Markings Seamline: This broken line, usually 5/8" (or desired seam allowance) from the cutting line indicates where to join the pieces. Many patterns, especially multi-size ones, do not have seamlines drawn on the patterns. Small Arrowsare on some seamlines to indicate stitching direction.

Zipper Marking. If you're sewing a garment that requires a zip, you may find a Zipper Marking on your pattern. This marking is a solid line with an arrow pointing inwards on either side — one at the top of the line (beginning of the zipper) and one at the bottom (bottom

of the zipper).
