Universal Credit – 12 things you need to know if you 've ... Universal Credit: What you need to know as job-hunting rules restart. 30 June 2020. From 1 July people claiming Universal Credit will begin to see a return of job-seeking requirements, which have been paused since 30 March due to Covid-19. The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) has said work coaches will be calling all claimants to help them prepare for work, although what people will need to do will depend on their Claimant Commitment.

Briefly, Universal Credit — as gradually introduced throughout Great Britain since October 2013 — is 'a social security benefit for people of working age. 'It combines " means tested " support for adults, children and housing cost into one benefit. '
