Transnational feminism developed out of postcolonial and women of color feminisms, both of which critiqued the idea that "sisterhood is global" (see Robin Morgan, *Sisterhood is Global*, New York: Feminist Press at CUNY, 1984). While Morgan's 1984 book was a paradigmatic articulation of this viewpoint, the notion of global sisterhood had been circulating since the late 1960s in "global" and "international" feminisms that used largely comparative approaches to women's issues in ...
